This is actually an old bymn called 'Gwahoddiad' (Invitation) which also goes by the name above, which is the first line of the song. Althought it feels very Welsh, the English words and the tune were actually written in 1872 by the American Methodist minister Lewis Hartsough in Iowa. Lots of airs for hoppular ymns have entered to 'trad' repertiore in Wales. If some of those longer notes (especially the high D) are a bit unstable on your pipes, play them really stracato an use them as an ornament. You can also break the melody into two halves and repeat AABB if you want.

Tune the drone to D.
